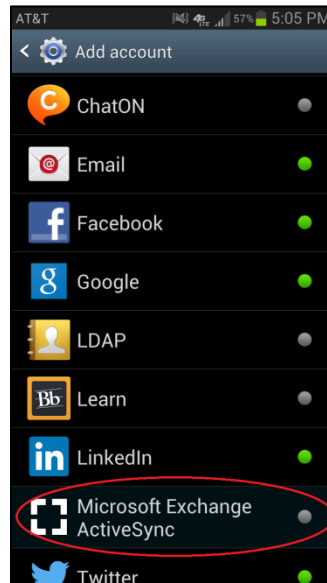


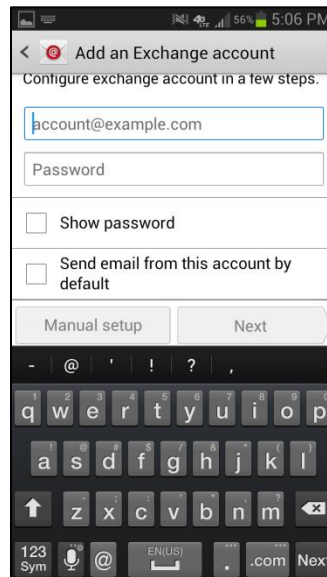
HOW TO: Setup your iPhone with ActiveSync

The following steps will walk you through connecting your Android phone to the UWITC email system.


1. To add an exchange account to your Android device, open settings, and scroll down to the accounts section. Then, click “Add Account”. Then, choose “Microsoft Exchange ActiveSync”.



2. Now, fill in your email and password, and click “Manual Setup”.




3. On the Exchange server settings page, add uwde in front of \username under domain\username. Then, under Exchange Server, type webmail.uwitic.org



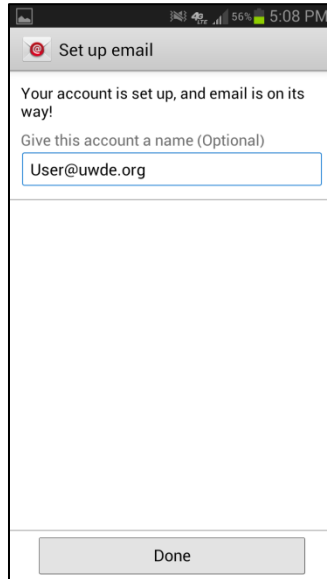
